Labor-to-Labor Walk Script & Instructions

- 1) Thank you for volunteering this morning! Your efforts will make the difference for working families.
- 2) Only go to those houses shown on the list. The lists are organized by odd / even house numbers on separate pages by street with the streets in alphabetical order.
- 3) When someone answers the door, ask for the person listed on the canvas sheet. If he or she is not home, speak with an adult in the household.
- 4) Introduce yourself as a union brother/sister and ask them to read the flier. Let him or her know that their union supports the election of name of candidate(s) and office(s).
- 5) If no one is home, leave the flier with a brief note as follows:

**“Sorry I missed you.
Your union brother/sister,”
Sign it and identify your union affiliation**

- 6) Please record each member’s candidate preference, undecided, not home, deceased, or bad address as indicated on canvas sheets. If the member does not know who they will vote for, record as undecided.
- 7) If you are unsure how to respond to someone’s concern, be honest. Explain that you are a union volunteer and not an expert on all the issues. Tell him / her that you will find out where the candidate(s) stands on the issue they care most about and get back to them (*confirm their phone number*).
- 8) Please make a note about all questions on walk sheet and bring each to the attention of the staff.
- 9) When you complete the walk, please return the packet to the staging location in page order with all maps included.
